## **Donation Guidelines**

The Show Low Youth Recreation & Sports Foundation is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to supporting youth programs that are under-funded or without funding (over and above normal budget items). The foundation is administered and run by volunteers with no paid staff. Formed in 2003, the foundation has successfully contributed over \$2,100,000 to youth groups in the Show Low, Linden, Pinedale, Clay Springs and Vernon areas of Arizona's White Mountains.

Show Low Youth Recreation & Sports Foundation's goal is to raise money to help support youth education, recreation, and sports programs in our area in order to enhance the quality of life and provide for educational and recreational opportunities and guidance to the youth of the White Mountains.

### Who Can Apply?

To be eligible to apply for funds, your organization must:

 Serve the youth of Show Low, Linden, Pinedale, Clay Springs or Vernon areas of the White Mountains.

#### What Do We Fund?

Although we accept other kinds of proposals, preference is given to requests that meet our mission to support youth education, recreation, and sports programs.

#### What Don't We Fund?

Show Low Youth Recreation & Sports Foundation is not able to provide monetary support for:

- Any program, project, or item which normal budget items should cover.
- Any program, project, or item in which the funds allocated by the Show Low Youth Recreation & Sports Foundation are used to purchase items that do not remain with the program/project.
- Stipends
- Organizations that advocate or support policies which are inconsistent with Show Low Youth Recreation & Sports Foundation's policies.

#### Additional Information:

- Funds allocated by the Show Low Youth Recreation & Sports Foundation must be claimed in the calendar year in which they are allocated.
- Unclaimed funds do not roll over and are considered forfeited.
- Funds are allocated based on the donation application provided to the Foundation Board of
  Directors. If a funding request changes after funds are allocated, the request must be approved by
  the Foundation Board of Directors prior to the distribution of funds to the organization.
